Dear friends.

It would be an understatement to say that 2020 was a year full of challenges and change. While our daily lives were upended by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Les Turner ALS Foundation's commitment to providing the best quality of care and support to those affected by ALS during these uncertain times never wavered. Spurred by the resiliency of people living with ALS, the pandemic pushed us to be nimble and resourceful and shift how we provide essential information and offer vital services.

As an organization, the pandemic made us stronger and more forward-thinking.

You are receiving this report because you have supported the Foundation as we faced these challenges together. Through your generous donations, sponsorships, volunteerism and overall involvement, you have helped change the life of someone living with ALS today or someone who will be diagnosed tomorrow.

2020 started off with a record-breaking in-person Hope Through Caring Gala on February 22 at Chicago's Radisson Blu Aqua with over 560 people. Who could have predicted that it would be our last in-person event of 2020? In March, we shifted to all virtual programming for the remainder of the year. Support Group meetings were moved to Zoom, and we implemented a robust telehealth platform for

ALS Support Services Coordinator visits and clinic appointments at our Lois Insolia ALS Clinic at the Les Turner ALS Center at Northwestern Medicine.

Thanks to our loyal donors, overall donations and fundraising events remained strong throughout 2020, including our Strikeout ALS 5K and 1 Mile Run, Walk and Roll and the ALS Walk for Life, and end of year giving broke recent records.

Our ALS research program at the Les Turner ALS Center at Northwestern Medicine did not miss a beat, with six groundbreaking basic science and clinical research projects fully funded in 2020. In addition, there has been tremendous headway in new ALS treatments and clinical trials, including rapid enrollment of patients in the breakthrough HEALEY ALS Platform Trial.

As we write this, there is much hope that the impact of vaccinations will help us return to a more normal way of life. Our primary concern, as always, is the health and safety of our extended Les Turner ALS family, of which you are an essential part. In 2021, we expect that our major fundraising events and services will be delivered in a hybrid model for the future, with a mix of in-person and virtual components to ensure the safety of all involved.

Because of you, we are a leader in comprehensive ALS care, allowing thousands of people affected by ALS to count on us. Thank you!

#### **FUNDRAISING EVENTS**



In what would be our last in-person fundraiser of the year on February 22, 2020, the Hope Through Caring Gala raised a record-breaking \$940,000.



In July, the first-ever virtual Strike Out ALS 5k & 1 Mile Run, Walk and Roll raised nearly \$60,000.



Our virtual ALS Walk for Life in September **raised over \$560,000** and allowed our supporters to form teams and walk safely and conveniently in their own community. By going virtual, we were joined by Walk participants from 32 states and three countries.



#### A NATIONAL LEADER IN **MULTIDISCIPLINARY CARE**

Our Lois Insolia ALS Clinic at the Les Turner ALS Center at Northwestern Medicine, one of the first multidisciplinary ALS clinics in the country, continues to be a nationwide leader and is at the forefront of clinical care and ALS research. In addition to the multidisciplinary care that patients receive at the Clinic, they work with the Foundation's support services team to receive individualized support for themselves and their loved ones.

Studies show that patients living with ALS who participate in a multidisciplinary clinic generally report a high level of satisfaction with their care, stay healthier and have improved health care outcomes, something we've known since 1986.

Despite the pandemic and shift to telehealth, patient appointments at our Lois Insolia ALS Clinic increased by 13 percent for new ALS visits and 5 percent for return ALS visits in 2020, reflecting the great need in the community.



**Enrollment in the breakthrough HEALEY ALS** Platform Trial, an innovative study designed to accelerate the path to effective treatments for ALS, commenced at our Lois Insolia ALS Clinic in Fall 2020.




